

Overview

The International University Foundation Programme (IUFP) is a Nine months full-time pre-degree course, which offers students a fast track alternative to GCE A levels /Senior Secondary/12th Grade and an entry route to prestigious Universities for degree courses. The programme is aimed at International students seeking admittance into Universities after one year of study.





Examinations are held twice a year in June & December

COURSE DETAILS

The course is designed to be completed over a period of one year (actually nine months), though students enrolled on the Intensive Scheme can complete their course in six months (usually between January and June).

SUBJECT COMBINATION

Core Subjects: - Academic English, Study Skills & IT Applications

Elective Subjects: - Accounting Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Computing,
Economics, Government and Politics Law, Mathematics, Physics, Psychology,
Sociology

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Prospective IUFP students must have completed Secondary / High School/ Grade X
- ▶ They must possess 5 Credits at GCSE 'O' Level standard (or equivalent) which must include English language and Mathematics.
- A student must be at least 16 years old

Notes:

- > IELTS with 6.5 bands is mandatory score for progression to higher level.
- ➤ The duration of each program is subject to the student's individual performance in completing each level unit assignments on time & university intakes for progression to higher level.
